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Learning Math

Math helps children solve different kinds of problems. Read this section to learn how to help your child with math.

Math is about learning to solve problems.

Children learn formulas to help them. **Formulas** are rules for solving problems.

Children learn to ask questions about their work:

- How did I solve this problem?
- What steps did I use?
- Did I do it right?
- Why didn't the answer come out like I thought it would?
- How will I know how to solve a problem like this if I see it again?
